

### *Rules of Four Seasons Farm*

*The rules of the barn are enforced to promote safety and respect for others.*

- *Helmet required while riding*
- *No smoking*
- *Visiting dogs must remain on leash and in control at all times*
- *Sweep up after your horses before you ride*
- *Stallions must be handle in the safest manner*
- *Clean up any manure in the arenas after riding or free lunging*
- *Be respectful of others tack and do not uses it without permission*
- *Do not help yourself to feed or shavings*
- *Report any broken or damaged equipment so it can be repaired or replaced*
- *Follow proper close down procedure if you are last to leave barn*
- *Keep it fun...NO DRAMA*
- *Parking in front of the barn is only permitted if you are a vet, farrier, or if you are unloading or dropping off. (Jane you can still park there on snowy & icy days ☺)*
- *Follow proper ring etiquette.*
